This form is used by the Commonwealth Diploma Coordinators to enroll their district/school into the program and list students as candidates – showing the students’ names as they will appear on the Commonwealth Diplomas.

## [CD Student Checklist](#)

This form is used by the Commonwealth Diploma Coordinators for each student as a checklist to ensure that the student has completed all of the requirements as outlined in the form by the date of graduation. This form is due the same time as the candidates list. If for any reason the student does not complete these requirements the diploma will be returned to KDE.

## [CD Program Regulations](#)

The Commonwealth Diploma Program 704 KAR 3:340, the Governing Regulation. RELATES TO: KRS 156.031, 156.070, 156.160. STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 156.070, 156.160. NECESSITY AND FUNCTION: KRS 156.031 requires that administrative regulations relating to statutes amended by the 1990 Kentucky Education Reform Act be reviewed, amended if necessary, and resubmitted to the Legislative Research Commission prior to December 30, 1990; KRS 156.070 authorizes the State Board for Elementary and Secondary Education to prescribe such courses of study, curriculums, and programs as it deems necessary for the common schools; and KRS 156.160 requires the State Board for Elementary and Secondary Education to adopt administrative regulations determining the courses of study for the different grades and the requirements for graduation from offered courses. A Commonwealth Diploma shall be issued to students completing a Commonwealth Diploma Program.

## [CD District AP Public and Non-Public Vouchers](#)

These forms are used by the Commonwealth Diploma Coordinators of districts/schools (including private and diocese schools) to calculate the total reimbursement for the number of students who received a composite AP Test Score of 8 or better on three AP exams. Public school students are reimbursed through their districts. Non-Public schools reimbursements are made directly to the students.

## [CD Student AP Public and Non-Public Forms](#)

These forms are used by the Commonwealth Diploma Coordinators of districts/schools (including private and diocese schools) to list students who qualify for the reimbursement. Lists the students’ names, addresses (non-public only), the name of the three AP exams, and the exam scores. Copy is sent of students’ AP test scores reports to verify their eligibility.
