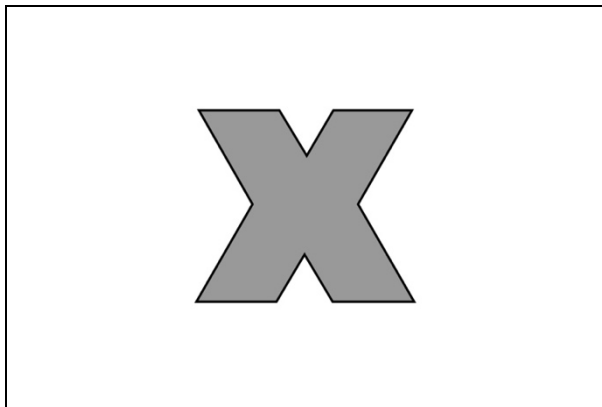

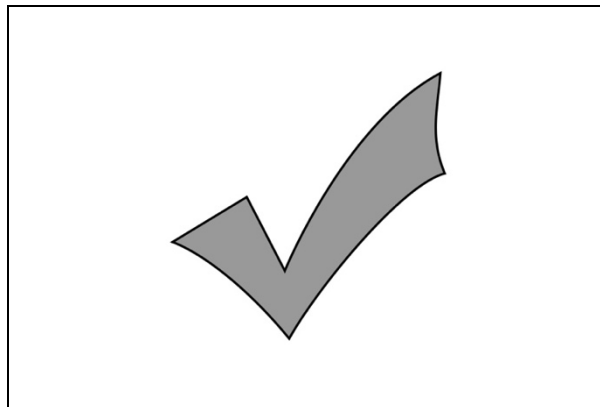
Text Coding:

Response Option	<i>Response Rationale</i>
a. No, it takes food away from home.	<i>The student identifies a concern with canned food drives but does not recognize it as a way to show good citizenship.</i>
b. Yes, it helps feed other people. (Correct)	<i>The student explains how donating food to a canned food drive is an example of good citizenship.</i>
c. Not enough information	<i>The student does not understand the relationship between donating to a canned food drive and good citizenship.</i>
