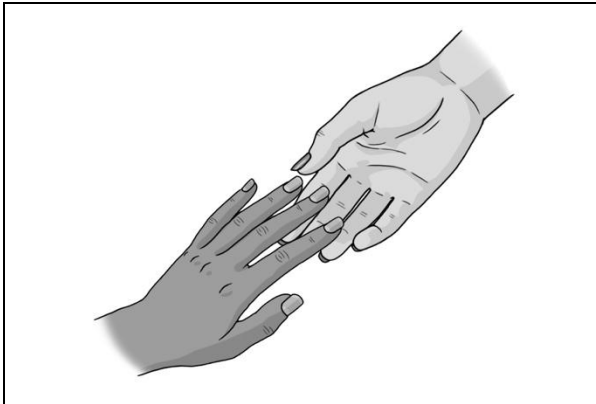

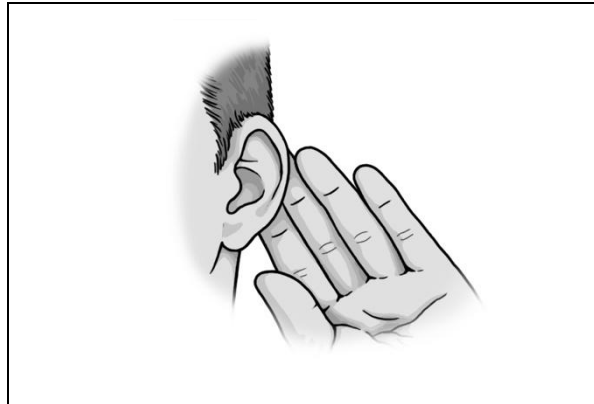

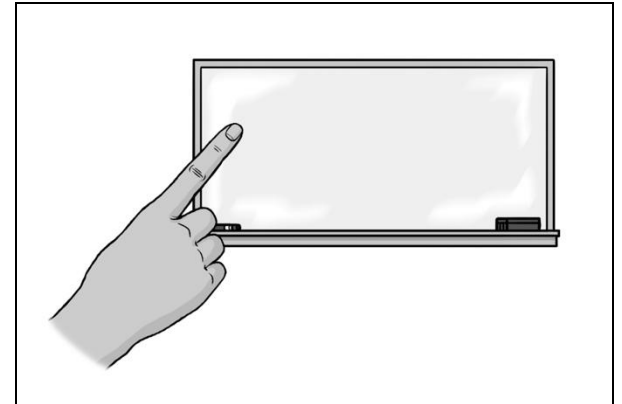

Before beginning task administration, please ensure that all conditions specified in the administration protocol (starting on page 9 of the Administration Guide Overview and Attainment Task Administration) have been met. Inform the student that the task is about to start by saying, “We are about to start the task, and I am going to ask you some questions.”

All questions from this task are available for presentation to the student in the material Reading 6 E Attainment Task Questions for Student Use.

Explain to the student that they will be reading a text and will then answer a few questions about the text. Present the student with Reading 6 E The Country Music Hall of Fame (Reading 6 E The Country Music Hall of Fame Picture Board may be presented as a support for the student). Have the student read, or read to the student, the text Reading 6 E The Country Music Hall of Fame.

2. “What is the meaning of the word *educates*?”

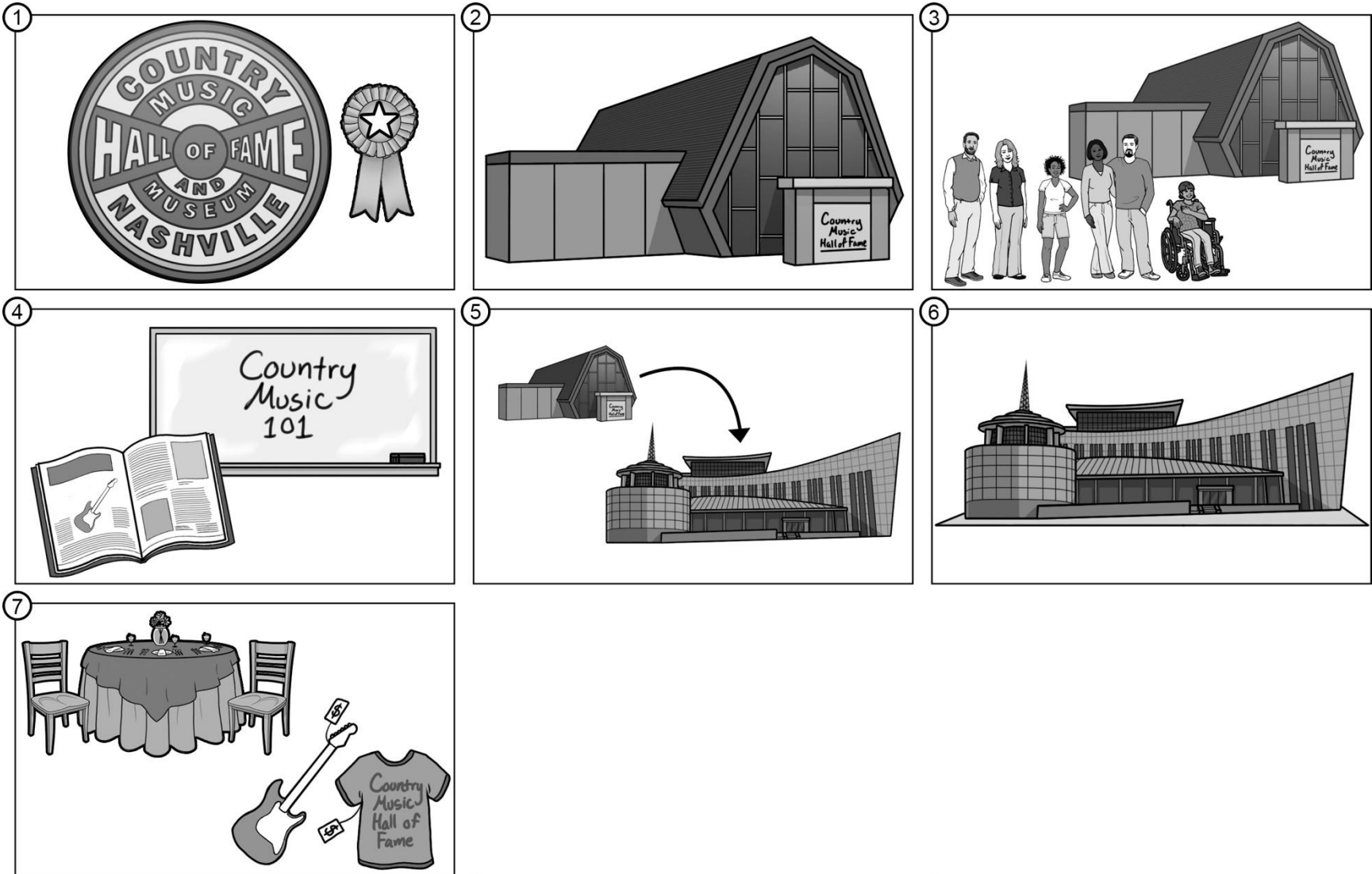
Response Option	Response Rationale
a. To help	<i>The student determines the action to be helpful but does not identify the intent of the clarifying phrase that follows the sentence.</i>
b. To listen	<i>The student focuses on the subject of music and determines that the word is related to music.</i>
c. To inform (Correct)	<i>Using the clarifying phrase that follows the sentence, the student correctly determines that the phrase clarifies the meaning of the word educate and selects inform.</i>
