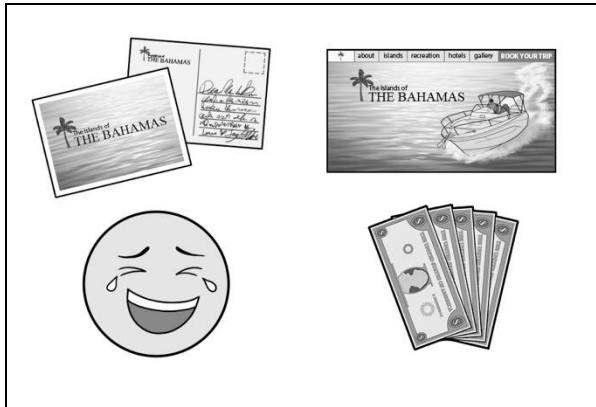

The postcard talks about enjoying a trip and the website is a place to purchase a trip.



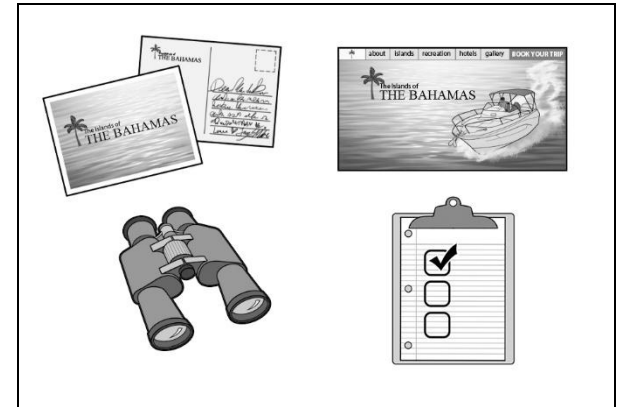
b.

Before beginning task administration, please ensure that all conditions specified in the administration protocol (starting on page 9 of the Administration Guide Overview and Attainment Task Administration) have been met. Inform the student that the task is about to start by saying, “We are about to start the task, and I am going to ask you some questions.”

All questions from this task are available for presentation to the student in the material Reading 7 F Attainment Task Questions for Student Use.

Explain to the student that they will be reading a text and will then answer a few questions about the text. Present the student with Reading 7 F Postcard. (Reading 7 F Postcard Picture Board may be presented as a support for the student). Have the student read, or read to the student, the text Reading 7 F Postcard.

Present the student with Reading 7 F Vacation Website.

Response Option	Response Rationale
a. The postcard talks about enjoying a trip and the website is a place to purchase a trip. (Correct)	<i>The student correctly analyzes each media’s portrayal of the subject.</i>
b. The postcard is about plans to move to the Bahamas and the website is about a visit.	<i>The student analyzes each media’s portrayal of the subject but focuses on one important aspect of each portrayal, excluding additional aspects that affect the overall meaning.</i>
c. The postcard is about a special tour and the website is where the tour was planned.	<i>The analyzes the portrayal of the subject for each media, but attributes additional meanings that are not included in the text.</i>

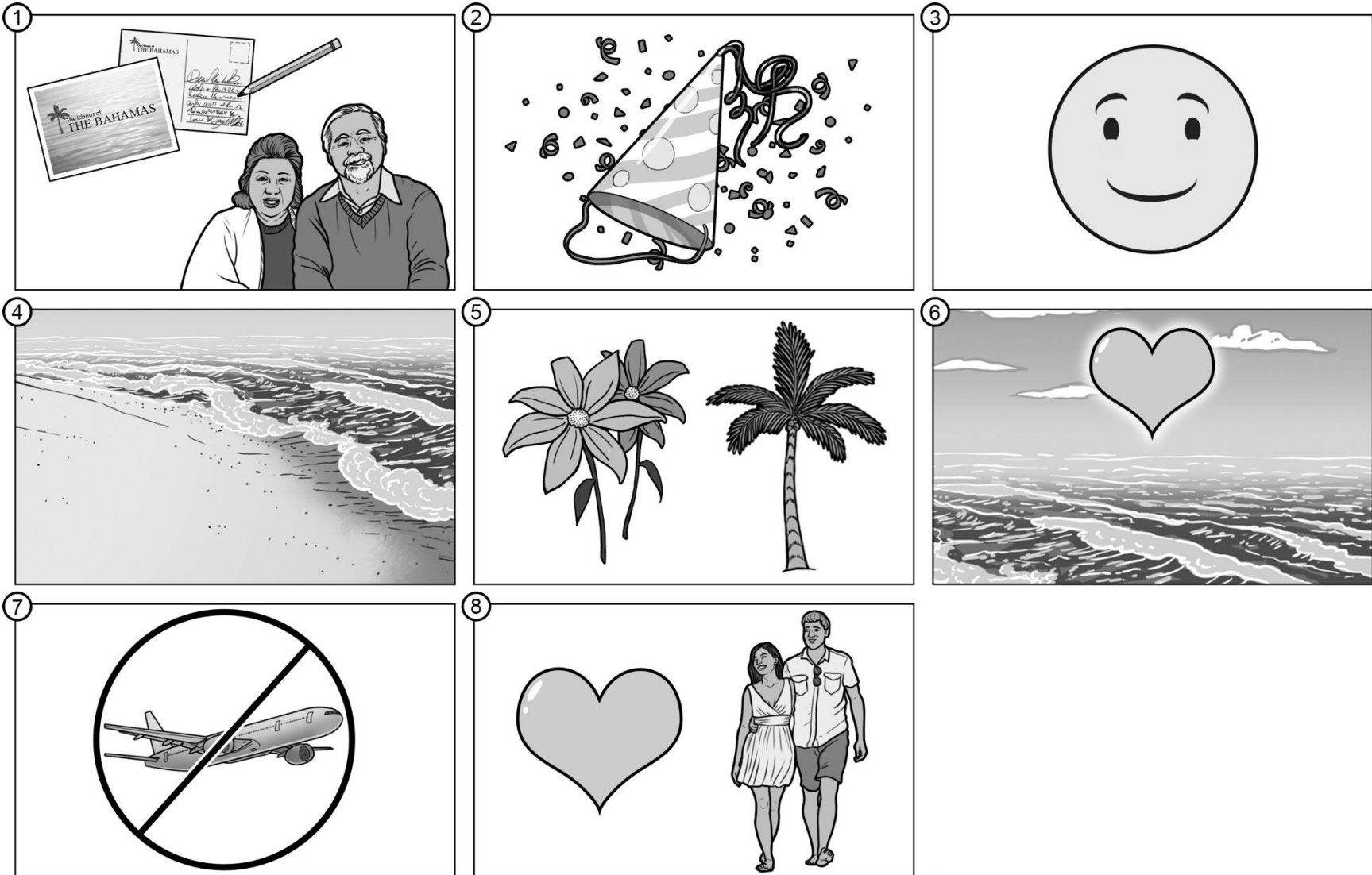
