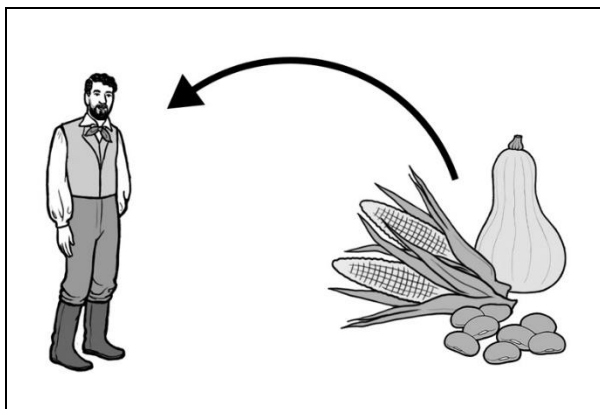

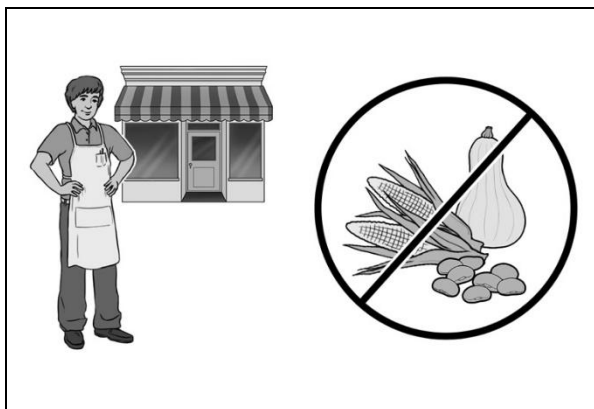

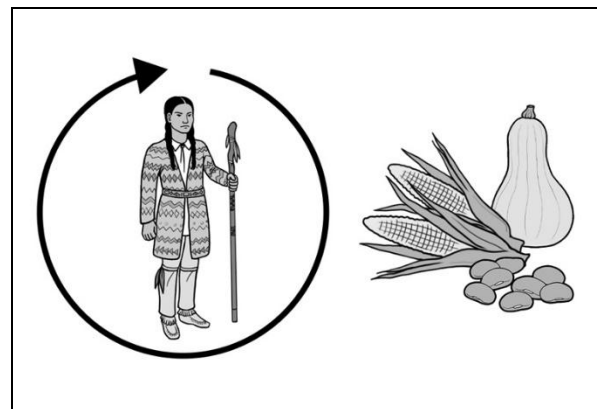

1. “American Indians farmed corn, beans, and squash. Early settlers were not familiar with these foods. How did this change in diet for early settlers impact us today?”

Response Option	Response Rationale
a. Americans have adopted these foods into their diet. (Correct)	<i>The student understands that the American Indians shared food cultures with the colonists that are still in use today.</i>
b. These foods are not available in stores.	<i>The student recognizes that these foods were eaten in early America but does not recognize they are still eaten today.</i>
c. Only American Indians can eat this food.	<i>The student understands that the crops were farmed by American Indians but does not understand how this impacts citizens today.</i>
