Review of the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment

- ▶ The partner group should meet twice per year (Fall of 2020 may be held virtual)
- ▶ Stakeholders must include representation from the following groups at a minimum:
 1. Representatives of CTE programs, including teachers, career guidance & academic counselors, principals, and other school leaders, administrators, and specialized instructional support personnel & paraprofessionals

Review of the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (cont. 2)

2. Representatives of postsecondary CTE programs' faculty and administrators
3. Representatives of state and local Workforce Boards and a range of local/regional businesses and industries
4. Parents and Students
5. Representatives of Special Populations
6. Representatives of students whose parents are in active duty military
7. Representatives of regional/local agencies serving out-of-school youth, homeless, or at-risk youth

Review of the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (cont. 3)

- ▶ The following items need to be covered when reviewing the CLNA:
- ❖ To ensure Programs of Study are:
 - Responsive to community employment needs
 - Align with employment priorities in the state, regional, or local economy; including in-demand industry sectors (State sectors are Business/IT, Advanced Manufacturing, Health Care, Transportation/Logistics, and Construction)
 - Informed by labor market information
 - Designed to meet current, intermediate, and long-term labor market projections
 - Allow employer input into the development of programs of study

Review of the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (cont. 4)

- ▶ Identify and encourage work-based learning opportunities
- ▶ Ensure funding is used in coordination with other local resources
- ▶ Provide in-put on annual updates to the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment for the local Perkins application
- ▶ Minutes of the meeting must be kept and uploaded in GMAP for the 21-22 grant year
- ▶ Minutes must include a members list of all attendees
