No Data Hostages

Co-Op Rules

Believe it or not, a devil’s jump is widely considered a good thing. It is believed to ward off evil in newborn babies. Controversy aside, we all know “the devil is in the details”. When it comes to co-op, there are very specific details. This legislative mandate can be easily overlooked, but you must follow the co-op regulation, [705 KAR 4:041](#). The regulations include the following:

A student must fit one of these categories:

- a. Be enrolled in a course included within the student’s chosen career pathway within the same academic year;
- b. Be a completer in the career pathway they are co-oping in by the end of their junior year; or
- c. Be Enrolled in an approved pre-apprenticeship program.

If your student does not meet one of these criteria, they cannot legally co-op. Review your enrollments. Review your data. Make sure you keep it in proper order when discussing and advising your students about co-op.

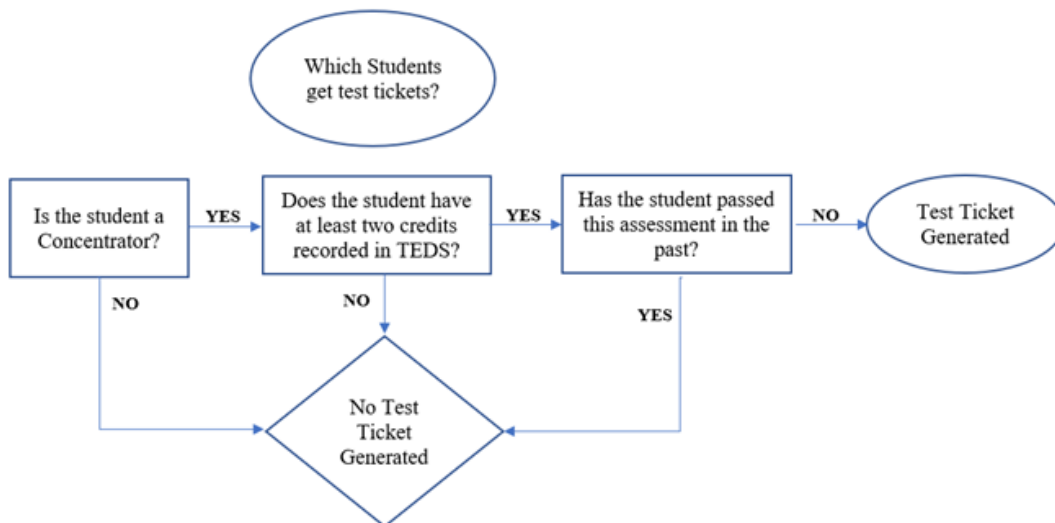

“Jump On It”

EOP and TRACK Test Ticket Report is Open

It’s time to jump on it! Test tickets are being generated for EOP and TRACK based on data in TEDS. Begin to review your Ticket Reports to ensure your data is accurate. Remember: For a student to generate a test ticket, they must meet ALL requirements for the ticket. The flow chart shows how tickets are generated. You cannot make changes to test tickets based on school or district level errors from last year UNLESS the student is currently enrolled in the same pathway where the mistake was made. You have until **February 1, 2024**, to update and verify any required data for EOP and TRACK. There is also the option to take industry certifications to meet requirements to become state transition ready.

How Clean Is Your Data?

You ever get that little twitch in your eye when you see something just isn't right? Me too. Our TEDS world is all about data. The accuracy of that data is the difference between a little twitch and when my left eye jumps. Please don't rush through the motions. Prevent those eye jumps. Keep this in mind as you work your TEDS data:

- ◇ When you enroll students in pathways,
 - ◆ The student should know they are in that pathway (no surprises).
 - ◆ The correct credit hours must be posted. Then, **credit hours must be updated whenever they change on the official transcript** (e.g., end of semester/trimester).
- ◇ When a student earns an industry certification for their chosen pathway, it should be properly entered in TEDS as soon **as the information is received from the instructor** and in the same school year it is earned.
- ◇ Once a student meets the definition of concentrator, that should be properly noted in IC and **imported** into TEDS when it happens.
- ◇ **You must review and update the data one last time at the end of the school year** (before your local IC is locked for the year) to **ensure data accuracy**.
- ◇ **NO DATA HOSTAGES. Clean data is happy data.**
