



KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION ADVISORY GROUP TOPIC SUMMARY

Purpose: The Testing Board of Review (TBR) and the commissioner of education work together to ensure the integrity of all state-required assessments is maintained. 703 KAR 5:080 charges the Testing Board of Review with providing a recommendation to the commissioner of education regarding testing allegations reported to the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE).

Summary of Discussion: The members of the Testing Board of Review reviewed 34 testing allegation cases concerning the administration of state-required assessments in accordance with 703 KAR 5:080 and 703 KAR 5:070.

The members determined that 34 of the 34 cases presented were violations of 703 KAR 5:080 and/or 703 KAR 5:070. No cases were held over until the next meeting for clarification.
