COMMENTS FROM WILLIAM "BILL" TWYMAN, KENTUCKY BOARD OF EDUCATION CHAIR

The Kentucky Board of Education (KBE) held its second special work session on April 11 to continue studying the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and current proposals for Kentucky's new assessment and accountability system. The presentation was facilitated by Rhonda Sims, KDE Associate Commissioner of the Office of Assessment and Accountability, and Brian Gong, Executive Director of the Center for Assessment.



The board reviewed the proposals for a variety of the system's components, which involve student proficiency, growth, achievement gap closure, transition readiness, school improvement and opportunity and access. An additional proposal also centers on the creation of a competency-based education and assessment pilot. The proposal reflects a number of rated measures, which would impact a school and district's overall performance rating, as well as a variety of public reporting options. The administrative regulations that will guide the new accountability system requirements are to be reviewed by the board for a first reading in June.

BOARD HEARS UPDATE ON THE OUTCOMES OF THE 2017 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

During its regular meeting on April 12, the Kentucky Board of Education (KBE) heard an update on the bills passed in the recent legislative session. Much of the discussion focused on the education bills that will require action by the KBE and implementation by the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE), such as Senate Bill 1 (standards, assessment and accountability system) and HB 520 (charter schools). 2018-2020 BIENNIAL BUDGET UPDATE PRESENTED

Associate Commissioner Robin Kinney and Budget Director Charlie Harman began by reviewing state budget terminology and operational definitions, as well as what current funding sources exist for KDE and the various purposes for which the funds are earmarked. Kinney and Harman then informed the board of the timeline and process for creating the agency's biennial budget requests. Next steps include discussions regarding the baseline budget and priorities at the next two KBE meetings (June and August), with approval of the 2018-2020 agency requests at the October regular meeting.
