

**The Kentucky Board of Education (KBE) held the United We Learn/Teaching and Learning Committee meeting on December 4, 2024. The committee met both virtually and in-person at the Kentucky Department of Education, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort KY. **I. Call to Order**

**A. Kentucky United We Learn Council Update**

KDE Chief Performance Officer Karen Dodd and KDE Strategic Data Analyst Leslie McKinney presented an update on the Kentucky United We Learn Council's October 2024 convening. Dodd shared information regarding next steps for the council, which included a series of town halls in each of the eight co-operatives and Jefferson County. She also said they are planning a virtual Spanish town hall. The town halls will be an opportunity for KDE to share the proposed assessment and accountability framework more broadly and to hear from more stakeholders, Dodd said. Chair Bloodworth thanked the team for the update.
