Description	MAP Growth is a web-based computer adaptive assessment used to identify students at risk of poor academic outcomes in reading for grades K-12.

Cost	\$7.50 per student
Frequency	3 times per year with an optional summer administration
Length	45 minutes per student on average

Norms Available	Yes – Grade Level Norms
