

EXPLANATION: HB 563 (2021) AMENDED KRS 158.120 TO REQUIRE THAT BY JULY 1, 2022, LOCAL BOARDS ADOPT A NONRESIDENT PUPIL POLICY TO GOVERN THE TERMS UNDER WHICH THE DISTRICT SHALL ALLOW ENROLLMENT OF NONRESIDENT PUPILS.

Nonresident Student Enrollment

CRITERIA FOR APPROVAL

The Superintendent will approve the request for enrollment of nonresident students in the local schools, provided all of the following conditions are met:

1. When the payment, or arrangement for payment, of tuition as established by the Board is made in advance to the Superintendent and is acceptable to the Superintendent;
2. The student has not been expelled from the school in which he was last enrolled;
3. The student is not under suspension from the school in which he is or was enrolled;
4. The student does not have an unacceptable history of disciplinary problems;
5. Class sizes and grade level organizational pattern will allow enrollment of the student;
6. No district vehicles will be required to leave the school district to pick up the student;
7. The student entering grades 4-12 has a minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 and has received at least a 3.0 G.P.A. for the semester prior to enrollment;
8. The enrollment is made within ten (10) days of the beginning of the semester;
9. The student has less than seven (7) days of unexcused absence during the previous year and/or less than five (5) days of unexcused absence during the semester prior to enrollment.

The Superintendent may provide exemptions to these criteria for enrollment.

APPEAL PROCESS

When the decision of the Superintendent is not satisfactory, an appeal may be made to the Board of Education. The decision of the Board is final.
