Nonresident Students

The District shall allow nonresident students to enroll in the District pursuant to existing Admissions and Attendance Policy 09.12, Tuition Policy 09.124, and related procedures.

DEFINITION

Nonresident students are those students who reside with their legal parents/guardians outside the boundaries of the District. Residency cannot be established through living with a relative or friend within the District.

CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT

Contingent upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and approval of the Board, nonresident students who wish to enroll in the district's schools may be granted permission to do so under the following provisions:

- 1. The parent/guardian of the student must complete and submit the nonresident student application between July 15th and July 31st of the school year in which the student may be attending. Any application received after July 31st will not be considered for enrollment in the fall semester.
- 2. If there are more applicants than capacity openings, nonresident student applications will be placed on a waiting list.
- 3. Capacity must not have been reached in the class or grade level that the student will be enrolled in. K-8 capacity is defined as is allowable by the district's approved staffing allocations for the current school year. 9-12 capacity is defined as a maximum of 200 students per grade level.
- 4. An opportunity to enroll for the second semester only will be available each school year, provided that the parents/guardian complete and submit a nonresident application between December 15th and December 31st of the school year, providing grade level capacity is not currently met. Any application received after December 31st will not be considered for enrollment for the spring semester.
- 5. A nonresident student's good standing (consisting of grades, behavior, and attendance) will be assessed by the Superintendent or Designee at the conclusion of the school year before enrollment will be granted for the following school year.
- 6. Nonresident students shall be charged the same incidental fees as are required of all students, such as locker fees.
- 7. The District will not provide transportation outside of the district boundaries or between schools within the district to nonresident students.
