Nonresident Students

The District shall allow nonresident students to enroll in the District pursuant to existing Admissions and Attendance Policy 09.12, Tuition Policy 09.124, and related procedures.

Upon allowing nonresident pupil enrollment, the policy shall allow nonresident children to be eligible to enroll in any public school located within the District. The policy shall not discriminate between nonresident pupils, but may recognize enrollment capacity, as determined by the District. The nonresident pupil policy and any subsequent changes adopted by the Board shall be filed with the Kentucky Department of Education no later than thirty (30) days following their adoption.¹

CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT

Factors that may lead to dismissal at the end of the academic year may include:

- Poor attendance (ten {10} or more days unexcused absences and/or tardies);
- Behavior issues, including but not limited to expulsion, suspension or adjudication as guilty/convicted of homicide, assault, offense of state law or school regulations relating to weapons, alcohol, or drugs;
- Poor academic performance (failure to demonstrate desire to learn and/or failure to follow academic direction); and
- Chronic disruption of the school environment by the student.

APPEAL

Enrollment application decisions may be appealed to the Superintendent. If the decision of the Superintendent is not satisfactory, an appeal may be made to the board. The decision of the Board is final.

ANNUAL ENROLLMENT

Nonresident students will be understood as passive approval and as understood require one application per student concurrent enrollment as long as the student stays in good standing with the District. If a student transfers from the District the enrollment process will be repeated. The enrollment application process remains open year-round in order to accommodate those who may seek enrollment or move into the area afterwards.
