

## **Nonresident Students**

### **DEFINITION OF LEGAL RESIDENCE**

Except for emancipated pupils, the legal residence of a pupil is determined by the address of the legal residence of the parent or guardian and not by the address at which the pupil is living.

### **BOARD APPROVAL**

Contingent upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and approval of the Board, nonresident pupils may attend District schools when the following requirements have been met:

1. The non-resident student is not currently under any disciplinary action from another district (suspension, expulsion, placement in an alternative school)
2. Written request for admission has been submitted
3. Completion of the admission questionnaire
4. Official notification of acceptance has been received from the Superintendent
5. Payment of tuition

A non-resident student may be asked to return to their home district if any of the following conditions exist:

1. Cap size is exceeded in a class in which the non-resident student is enrolled
2. The non-resident student exhibits behavior that is disruptive to the learning environment
3. The non-resident student accumulates seven (7) unexcused absences in the course of a school year
4. The non-resident student is not making satisfactory academic progress (passing 75% of courses attempted)

The Board reserves the right to admit and assign all nonresident pupils. Admission will be reviewed annually.
