# **Nonresident Students**

#### **DEFINITION OF LEGAL RESIDENCE**

Except for emancipated pupils, the legal residence of a pupil is determined by the address of the legal residence of the parent or guardian and not by the address at which the pupil is living.

#### **BOARD APPROVAL**

Contingent upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and approval of the Board, nonresident pupils may attend District schools when the following requirements have been met:

- 1. The non-resident student is not currently under any disciplinary action from another district (suspension, expulsion, placement in an alternative school)
- 2. Written request for admission has been submitted
- 3. Completion of the admission questionnaire
- 4. Official notification of acceptance has been received from the Superintendent
- 5. Payment of tuition

A non-resident student may be asked to return to their home district if any of the following conditions exist:

- 1. Cap size is exceeded in a class in which the non-resident student is enrolled
- 2. The non-resident student exhibits behavior that is disruptive to the learning environment
- 3. The non-resident student accumulates seven (7) unexcused absences in the course of a school year
- 4. The non-resident student is not making satisfactory academic progress (passing 75% of courses attempted

The Board reserves the right to admit and assign all nonresident pupils. Admission will be reviewed annually.
