STUDENTS 09.1222

Nonresident Students

The District shall allow nonresident students to enroll in the District pursuant to existing Admissions and Attendance Policy 09.12, Tuition Policy 09.124, and related procedures.

Upon allowing nonresident pupil enrollment, the policy shall allow nonresident children to be eligible to enroll in any public school located within the District. The policy shall not discriminate between nonresident pupils, but may recognize enrollment capacity, as determined by the District. The nonresident pupil policy and any subsequent changes adopted by the Board shall be filed with the Kentucky Department of Education no later than thirty (30) days following their adoption.¹

DEFINITION

Nonresident students are those students who reside with their legal parents/guardians outside the boundaries of the District. Residency cannot be established through living with a relative or friend within the District.

CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT

Contingent upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and approval of the Board, nonresident students who wish to enroll in the District's schools may be granted permission to do so under the following provisions:

- 1. Payment of tuition
- 2. The student must be in good standing in the school district from which he/she is transferring;
- 3. The admission of the student will not exclude any resident student from attending school in the District; and
- 4. Enrollment of nonresident students will not cause the district of attendance to exceed state class size maximums.

STATUS OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

Nonresident students who are permitted to enroll in the District are generally accepted into the District for one (1) school year. During the school year, the student is expected to abide by all school rules and the Student Discipline Guidelines and is subject to the disciplinary procedures set forth therein.

During each school year, the Board may remove or dismiss a nonresident student for misconduct pursuant to <u>KRS 158.150</u> following applicable due process procedures.

At the end of each school year, the Superintendent or Superintendent's designee may remove or dismiss a nonresident student upon notice to the student's parent/guardian. Factors that may lead to removal or dismissal shall be:

- Poor attendance (ten (10) or more days unexcused absences or tardies);
- Behavior problems;
- Poor academic performance (failure to demonstrate desire to learn and/or failure to follow academic direction);
- Chronic disruption of the school environment by the student.
