College Readiness Exam Scores

1. How will students' ACT scores be connected to KEES? We have many students whose ACT score is higher than the SAT score?

The highest score obtained on a single test date prior to high school graduation is used to determine the KEES bonus award. ([link to KHEAA documentation](#))

ACT scores will still be populated for historical testing but won't be available going forward unless the district provides scores to KHEAA.

2. Will the KEES IC extract change to include SAT scores instead of ACT. KHEAA currently does the SAT conversion. Will that process continue, or will the exact SAT score be reported?

The KEES Extract currently includes ACT and SAT. We will work with Campus to update the report after the June 30 reporting window closes this year to include the new state administered SAT. This year's juniors SAT scores will be included next year if it's the highest SAT they've received.

4. I created a user group just for SSN removal, and added it to my tool rights, but it still says I do not have permission to access the page. I am the KSIS admin. How do I gain access?

Tools Rights must be added as individual tool rights.

5. Going back to the SSN Removal Tool, is there any need to keep staff SSN's for LEAD reporting?

No, SSNs are no longer used for LEAD. We switched to using EPSB IDs for matching.

They've never been required, but KDE recommends using them so data is easily available to answer questions that might be asked. [Summer School Calendar Setup Guide](#).

7. When will the End-of-Year Checklist for 2026 be available online?

The End of Year checklist will be available in the May KSIS Newsletter that will be published on or around April 25.

8. Question How close should the FRAM Eligibility Report match the Seek AT-Risk Report?
When should you be concerned?

Because the file is only pulled on Mondays, it is possible that any discrepancies may be due to when you are pulling the SEEK At Risk report. If you see large differences and you are pulling the report on Monday, please reach out to us and we will troubleshoot with you. It is possible someone in your district is doing cleanup between when we pull and when you create the report.

Homeless Children and Youth: Data Collection Updates

9. Is there any chance that the Homeless information will ever import as a data import in the records transfer tool?

Since the students start date for homeless needs to be added by the updated by the district and the fact that this is now part of IC core product, it is unlikely the data will be transferred as a data import instead of a transfer document. Having the district enter the record also ensures the homeless liaison is aware of the student transfer into the district.

10. Can a report be created for MV/ 12th graders that are unaccompanied?

The QA Homeless can be used to filter the data needed, let me know if you need assistance. [Windy Spalding](#)

11. Can student email addresses be added as fields so we can email students directly?

Many districts have the school email address in Campus for for students. There is a secondary email field too.

12. Do homeless students automatically roll over to the next year or does this have to be manually entered every year?

The homeless records do not roll from one year to the next. The students homeless identification must be determined each school year. Use QA Homeless Report and existing state published ad-hocs to ensure each student who was homeless is evaluated at the beginning of school year.

Behavior Data Standards and Reporting

13. I just want to make sure I understand. We have 2 behavior reports that keep pulling on our Safe Schools report as an ER04 error. The incidents happened on the last day of school for the 24-25 school year, but the behavior resolution didn't happen until this year. So are you saying that the "Date of Incident" needs to be the first day of school for the 25-26 school year? Then that will remove those from the Safe Schools report?

In the case you describe you have two options: 1) enter the behavior incident on the last day of school; then enter a new incident on the first day of school that is a non-safe schools event, like carry over event and add the resolution there. or 2) enter the behavior incident and resolution into the first day of school of next school year with a note that it occurred on the last day of the previous school year. 14. When clicking "Active Special Ed at Time of Incident" I only get SPED students who are on the error report. How do I get all SPED students with behavior resolutions for the year??

The first page will show error/warnings that need to be addressed. Use the [Click Here](#) button at the top of the page, then all data will export as excel.

15. Will we ever get more in-depth training on the Pivot Designer so that we can create our own Insights and tailor them to our own needs? I get a lot of questions about this and I feel that KDE should have some type of session, similar to this, that would highlight the Pivot Designer as there has never been a session on it and its ability.

I believe IC Campus Community has trainings on Pivot Designer that may assist. Not sure KDE has anything in-depth for this functionality. We can look into it. 16. Any movement on making insights a District-level tool? With a large district, it's hard to use the insights dashboard at the district office level because you have to view the data at each individual school.

This has been an outstanding request that KDE has had with IC. We have not received an update recently but can follow-up. Early Warning does now work to generate for all schools.

17. If we didn't use NTI, do we have to report anything?

Impactful Legislation for Data and Reporting

18. Would it be possible to modify the TEDS data entry (for CTE students) in IC in such a way that you could add and modify TEDS records in a mass entry instead of individually? An example would be when you have a class of 30 students that are all in the Digital Literacy course, in the E-Commerce Pathway. All will/should have the same start date, CIP code, attend hours, credit hours, objective and term data. Individual modification could be made where necessary.?

The request is an Infinite Campus modification/enhancement. OCTE will investigate the options with Infinite Campus.

19. Can you speak to the DPP duties that relate to SOAR 180?

The legislation indicates that the DPP will receive notifications that they may not have previously received. More information will be shared as it becomes available.

20. Does the SOAR team replace the FAIR Team?

21. No, SOAR teams do not replace FAIR teams. The SOAR initiative will start out as a pilot project with no less than 10 school districts and relates only to truancy. FAIR Teams were established as part of the juvenile justice reform in Senate Bill 200 and includes behavioral health support, substance abuse treatment, and other community-based resources.

22. Can you review the HS credit for 8th grade from the accountability KRS?

The agency will draft policy guidance in May related to all recently passed legislation.
