

Infinite Campus: Chronic Absenteeism

Custom Report: Chronic Absenteeism – The purpose of this report is to produce aggregate and detailed chronic absenteeism data. Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) defines chronically absent as a student who is present 90% or less of full-time equivalency. Both reports calculate school/district chronic absenteeism data based on full-time equivalency (FTE) attendance. KDE calculates chronic absenteeism by dividing student’s FTE present minutes by FTE instructional minutes and rounding to the nearest whole percent.

Aggregate report: absenteeism calculations by percentage ranges; numbers and percentages of students by grouping. To be included in the aggregate report, students must be enrolled at least 10 days in the school/district.

Detail Report: returns student-level aggregate FTE attendance data. This report can be used to identify specific students or groups of students at or nearing chronic absenteeism. If a student had two enrollments in one school during the year, attendance for both enrollments will be combined for the student. **Parent/guardian and address information are also available for districts to send out letters for those who are chronically absent.**

Selection Criteria: Select the Report Type you wish to run: Aggregate or Detail (default). The Infinite Campus Toolbar will control the school/district, calendar and year for which the report will generate.

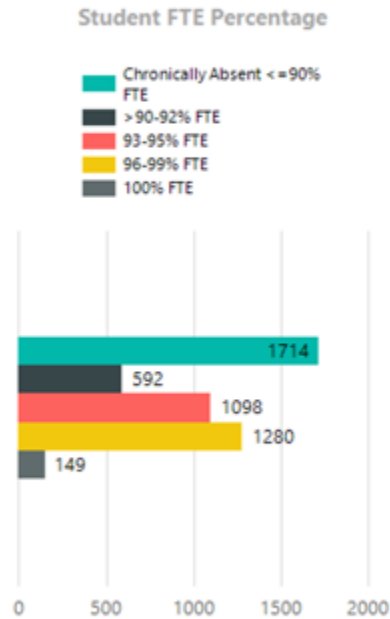

Note: Chronic Absenteeism is an Accountability - Opportunity & Access Measure

Proposed Ranges - Under consideration by KDE

- 5% or less of the total school population = 3 pts
- 6% to 10% of the total school population = 2 pts
- 11% to 15% of the total school population = 1 pt
- 16% or more of the total school population = 0 pt

Suggested report uses: (Open the report in Excel, then turn on the Filter option and freeze the headings.)

- Run the aggregate report to see percentage of chronically absent students by school/district. Chronic absenteeism is an Accountability – Opportunity & Access Measure and points are awarded for schools/districts with less than 16% of the student population chronically absent. Periodically share report with school and/or district leadership.
- Run the detail report and sort the report on “% FTE Present” to identify students who are chronically absent, or close to becoming chronically absent.
- Run the detail report and filter on “Chronic Absent” for Y to see only chronically absent students.
- Parent/guardian and address information has been added so districts can send out letters for those students who are chronically absent.
