Import Kentucky Academic Standards into Infinite Campus

Overview

Kentucky Academic Standards (KAS) are available for import from a certified competency framework as an interactive digital companion that can provide direct support for teachers who wish to utilize such features as standards-based grading in Infinite Campus (IC). Educators should continue to use the KAS documents available on KYstandards.org to design high-quality standards aligned instruction.



Preparation

- 1. Please email standards@education.ky.gov to request the required credentials to import KAS from IMS Global CASE Network.
- 2. A default rubric must be assigned from the district's existing list of score groups and rubrics. This rubric is applied to all imported standard groups but can be modified later through the Standards Bank. If multiple rubrics will be used, select the one that used for most standards during the import.


Import Procedure

 In Infinite Campus, navigate to the Standards Import Wizard Path: Grading & Standards / Standards Bank / Import Standards Standards Bank




If **Import Standards** is not available, check with your IC administrator. Users need tool rights to both the <u>Standards Bank</u> and the subright to the Standards Import Wizard to use this tool.

2. Enter the location information then click Next.



- b. Enter Client ID and Client Secret obtained by emailing standards@education.ky.gov.
- Scroll down to select Kentucky Department of Education as the Creator, then click Next. Standards Import Wizard




4. Select a framework to import then click **Next**.

Standards Import Wizard




5. The Import Defaults screen will take time to populate.

Standards Import Wizard




- a. **Default Rubric:** Select a <u>Rubric</u> from the district's existing list of score groups and rubrics. This rubric is applied to all imported standard groups but can be modified later through the Standards Bank.
- b. Item Type: Source frameworks may include a wide variety of item types (such as domains, clusters, etc.), but Campus supports only two types: groups and standards. Indicate whether each type identified in the framework should be imported as a group or a standard. If all items of an item type have children, it will default to a Group. After import, groups can be converted to standards. Only standards can be aligned to assignments and given grades.
 - i. The default selections produced the desired results for *KAS for Reading & Writing, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Computer Science,* and *Career Studies and Financial Literacy.*
 - ii. For *KAS for Health Education*, and *Physical Education* the default selection on item type Standard needs to be changed to publish as Standard.




- c. Click Next.
- 6. Review the Summary information. If the correct framework is shown, click Import.
