


## District Safe Schools Administrator,

Infinite Campus release .2327 that was pushed to district production sites on 7/26 contained two new regulated behavior events of V19: Hazing, 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and V20: Hazing, 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. These options are now available in the *State Event Code (Mapping)* drop list via Behavior | Admin | Event Types. Districts must follow the steps below to ensure new local behavior events are added with this mapping selection for school use starting with the 2023-24 school year.

- Select All Schools in the IC toolbar.
- Navigate to Behavior | Admin | Event Types
- Click New
- Complete fields as shown in screenshot for Hazing 1st Degree.



Repeat above steps to add Hazing, 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree.



Use of these behavior events will prompt a record on the Safe Schools report within the Assault or Violence category.

Section F of the <u>Behavior Data Standards</u> have been updated to provide definitions of these new behavior events.
