**Kentucky Specific**

Item	Description
<b>English Learners Extract</b>	All enrollment Service Types that meet all report criteria will now be included in the EL Demographics Extract in the following ranked order: P: Primary, S: Partial, and N: Special Education Services. The % Enrolled field has been removed from the EL Services Extract.
<b>Career Readiness</b>	The new Career Readiness tool is used to view, enter, track and report data related to students participating in work-based learning.
<b>Career Readiness Report</b>	A Career Readiness Report has been added to collect data on students who have a Career Readiness record tied to an approved Course State Code or have a Career Readiness record with work hours attached.

<b>Assessment</b>	The layout designs for the Test Information, Test Type, and Display Settings sections under the Test Detail of the Assessment Center have been updated to enhance user experience
<b>Assessment</b>	The tool search functionality has been updated to correctly return the path to the Assessment Center in both the classic version and the new navigation (New Look of Campus).
<b>FRAM Income Guide 23-24 School Year</b>	Updated the FRAM Income Eligibility Guidelines based on USDA guidance for the 23-24 school year.
<b>FRAM Reports User Interface Update</b>	The user interface has been updated for several FRAM reports: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eligibility Report</li> <li>• Permission Report</li> <li>• FRAM Letter Batch Report</li> <li>• Household Applications Report</li> </ul>

	<p>The Eligibility and Permission reports are now separate tools under FRAM &gt; Reports. Additionally, a Non-Reimbursable option has been to the Eligibility field of the Eligibility Report.</p>
<p><b>New Course Status Tool</b></p>	<p>A new Course Status tool has been added to the Course Master tools. This tool lists all of the Courses attached to a Course Master across Calendars for the Year selected in the Campus toolbar. The Link Status of each course is provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Linked - Grading setup matches between the Course and Master.</li> <li>• Course Controlled - Some elements of grading setup are unlocked at the Course Catalog and can therefore be managed at the Course level.</li> <li>• Desynced - Grading setup elements are locked at the Course Catalog level but do not match the grading setup at the course level.</li> </ul> <p>Filter the list of courses by Status using the Filter Courses buttons at the top.</p> <p>The Status Detail column indicates which grading setup elements the status applies to and whether those elements are Course Managed (unlocked at the Catalog) or Unlinked (no longer linked to the Course Master). The tool names in this column link to the respective tools for that Course.</p>
<p><b>Ignore Master Push Checkbox</b></p>	<p>The 'Ignore Master Push' checkbox on the Calendar tool has been updated to be governed by the tool rights for the Push All Course Masters tool, to make sure that only users who are responsible for pushing Course Master setup can modify this checkbox.</p>
<p><b>Special Education Documents Usability Updates</b></p>	<p>Several usability issues have been addressed to allow users to access tables, information icons, expand/collapse, and side panels within editors when the editor is placed in a Complete status. These updates apply to Plans and Evaluations that have been rewritten with the <b>New Look</b> of Campus</p>
<p><b>Message Center - Grading Services</b></p>	<p>The message sent when an error occurs when fetching Grading Services data has been updated to clarify whether the issue was related to making a connection to the integrations server or that the keystore failed to load.</p>
<p><b>NEW Scheduling Board</b></p>	<p>As part of an ongoing project to enhance the scheduling tools across the product, a NEW Scheduling Board is now available. This is the latest tool to be revamped and joins the Scheduling Center, the Staff Planner and the new Course Planner for the 2023-24 Scheduling season.</p> <p>The Scheduling Board - the new name for the Schedule Wizard - can be accessed without having to launch a separate window, without logging in a second time, AND without using JAVA or OpenJDK. It's available in both the New Look (Scheduling &amp; Courses   Scheduling   Scheduling Board) and the Classic View (Scheduling   Scheduling Board).</p>
<p><b>NEW Course Planner</b></p>	<p>As part of an ongoing project to enhance the scheduling tools across the product, a NEW Course Planner is now available. This is the latest tool to be revamped and joins the Scheduling Center, the Staff Planner and the new Scheduling Board for the 2023-24 Scheduling season.</p> <p>The Course Planner lists active courses in the selected school, requests for that course, how many sections need to be built to meet those requests, and the number of seats for that course. Teachers &amp; Rooms can be assigned, Scheduling Rules can be managed, and Placement Restrictions can be added for the Course.</p>

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
