Infinite Campus Release Highlights - Campus.2511

Kentucky Specific

Item	Description
Home Language	The Central American Indian (CAI) and South American Indian (SAI) languages were added to the Kentucky Home Primary Language dropdown. The Indian (0690) code was removed from the list, and any existing records with that code will be converted to North American Indian languages (1025).
School Information	The Exclude checkbox on the Kentucky School Information tool was removed.
Syncing to State	The logic for syncing the database objects between the district and state editions were updated to send data via a database event change, in addition to the existing syncing methods of forcing a manual sync or saving on the UI. Impacted database objects include Career Readiness, Early Learning KY, EL Accommodations, EL Services, Foster Care, Gifted Status KY, Homeless, Migrant, Preschool KY, Program Participation, TEDS KY and Title1 KY. An issue when a districtID is null on the State Edition side not removing the null districtID upon resync was fixed for Intervention and KECSAC records.

Core Product

Item	Description
Assessment	Child tests failed to import into the Assessment Center when they included scores, and the parent test had null values in some score fields. This issue has been resolved. When importing any test score data with a blank/NULL value for either Raw Score or Scale Score, those fields are set to NULL in the dbo.testScore table. Errors are no longer generated, and test score records are created without issues.
FRAM	The FRAM Verification tool has received a new user interface.
Grading Setup	The Standards Import has been updated to support the CASE 1.1 specification and allow cartridges to be imported from CASE Network 2. The Import workflow has also been improved to clarify and simplify the process. In the new workflow, users select a source for the cartridge, then select which frameworks should be imported. For each framework, users then select the item types for imported items, select a default rubric, and preview the hierarchy of groups and standards before completing the import.

Insights	An issue preventing templates from adjusting data to reflect the selected school/school year has been corrected. Template data now reflects the selected school/school year.

Item	Description
Messenger	Messenger 2.0 now supports embedding images directly in the message body. When an image is added, it is uploaded to the Campus Digital Repository and can be sent via Inbox or Email Delivery Modes. Users can insert images by dragging and dropping them into the message body, copying and pasting, or uploading from their computer using the file manager. Uploaded images are stored in an image manager for future use in other messages. The Inbox / Email - Inline Images option will need to be toggled on from the Digital Repository Preferences tool to enable this functionality.
Transcripts	Course records were duplicated on the transcript when the Group Options function was set to 'Grade'. They now display only once, regardless of the Group Options set for the Transcript.
Security	The maximum length for a username has been increased to 100 characters. An Authentication Type column was added to the Access Log. This column logs the authentication type of the user account login attempt (local Authentication, LDAP, or SSO). Additional measures were added to strengthen Campus Support's secure access to customer sites. This access is used to troubleshoot and assist districts with resolving support cases. To improve the user experience and lessen confusion, the following updates were made: • All "Two-Factor Authentication" mentions in the product have been updated to say "Multi-Factor Authentication". • The Require Authentication Frequency dropdown list now appears below the selected Multi-Factor Authentication option. • The "Require a Two-Factor Authentication code (Email-Based)" option has been renamed to "Require Email-Based Multi-Factor Authentication code (Third party authentication application required)" option has been renamed to "Require Time-Based Multi-Factor Authentication from a Third-Party App", and additional language was added to the editor to assist users in first logging in and using this option.
