Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.2527

Kentucky Specific

Item	Description
Immunizations	<p>We made several updates concerning Kentucky's immunization rules, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Converting Kentucky's hard-coded immunization rules to soft-coded and also making them read-only for all users. • Fixing all immunization extracts to correctly report these new rules. • Updating all immunization dose requirements. • Adding the Nightly Compliance Report to automatically calculate and refresh student vaccine compliance on a nightly basis. <p>See the Kentucky Immunization Rules article for additional details.</p>
District Information	<p>We made the County field on the District Information tool required for Kentucky users, and we locked the County attribute dictionary.</p>
Sync – Scope Year	<p>Data syncing between districts and state edition will change scope years.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2025-26 becomes the scope year (real time data syncing) • 2024-25 becomes the Minus 1 year (limited manual syncing) • 2026-27 becomes the Plus 1 year (limited manual syncing) <p>2023-24 becomes no longer available for any data synchronizing</p>

Core Product

Item	Description
Campus Digital Repository	<p>The Campus Digital Repository has been transitioned to use off-premise cloud storage for all users.</p>
Campus Instruction	<p>The Student Groups tool has been updated to improve the visual design of the tool. The tool now includes a Group View, which lists all of the groups for that section, the number of members, and available actions to take for that group. In the Student View, students are listed with their assigned groups.</p> <p>The process for creating student groups from Score Analysis has also been updated to improve usability.</p>
Campus Learning	<p>A new Section Feed tool has been released for Instruction users. This tool collects communications for a section, consisting of posts by teachers and students and their replies. Teachers can create posts and replies; students' communication options depend on the Section Feed Settings but may include posting, replying, and uploading attachments. To view a section's feed, click the speech bubbles icon in the Teaching Center or view the Classroom</p>

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	<p>screen. Section Feeds are enabled for students and parents via the Portal Display Options. A Section Feed Administration tool allows admins to view feeds for sections and resolve flagged replies.</p> <p>Teachers can now print quizzes for students unable to use computers. Printed quizzes closely resemble the digital versions taken by other students. Teachers also have the option of printing an answer key that includes the answers and settings selected.</p> <p>The process for manually scoring quizzes has been updated. To change the auto-calculated score for a question, click Edit Score and enter the new score. This process prevents auto-calculation logic from overwriting the manually-entered score if it is triggered again.</p>
Campus Student/Parent	<p>The toast messages that previously displayed for server errors in the top right corner of the screen in Campus Student and Campus Parent have been replaced by modal warnings for improved accessibility.</p>
Dependent Care	<p>Dependent Care is now available for use. Dependent Care assists school districts in offering school-age care for district students. Through this tool, school districts can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Schedule care for multiple scenarios through individual sessions • Session rosters • Offer payment, discount, and late fee charges • Student Session attendance along with emergency contacts and authorized pickup persons • Required registration forms
Enrollment	<p>An issue with the Firefox browser not allowing users to generate or print enrollment history has been corrected.</p>
Grading & Standards	<p>Users assigned correct tool rights to Course Master Information could not push changes to courses unless they were also assigned SIS Role. This has been corrected. In order to push Course Master data to courses, users need modify rights to the selected calendar and the following tool rights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read and Write rights to Course Masters and Courses to Push to Courses. • Read, Write, and Add rights to Course Masters and Courses to add Assessments, Categories, Grade Calc Options, and then Push to Courses.
Learner Planning	<p>An issue was resolved where the Related Service dropdown in the Specially Designed Instruction editor was not retaining selected values after saving. This fix applies to states with rewritten plans.</p>
Navigation	<p>The New Look of Infinite Campus has replaced Classic Campus. To learn more about this new version of Campus, see the Try the New Look of Infinite Campus article or watch the Latest Innovations video.</p>
Scheduling	<p>Moving a section's placement to another section based on placement suggestions caused negative sections to display on the Scheduling Board and caused a failure when saving changes. This has been corrected.</p> <p>The Scheduling Center showed a No Students Enrollment message in the Student Request Entry section. When a new Schedule Structure was selected, the students displayed. This has been corrected.</p> <p>Since the Campus.2511 Release, users who were assigned Read and Write rights to Add Course could not add a new course without also having Read, Write, and Add rights to Course Information. This has been corrected. Users can add courses with Read and Write rights to Add Course, and Read rights to Course Information.</p>
Security	<p>A new SAML – SSO Login Details report is now available. This report displays a record of all SAML login attempts for the past 7 days, detailing the:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timestamp • log ID (unique identifier given to each login attempt) • The username of the person who logged in (or attempted to log in),

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the record is information or an error occurred • If an error occurred, the error message that was presented • The SSO configuration used to validate the login • The attribute used for identification <p>Using this report, users can audit SSO logins on their system and troubleshoot issues they may be experiencing.</p> <p>Descriptive error messages were added to the SSO Service Provider Configuration. Now, when the system is unable to access the certificate repository, users will be alerted of this issue and its impact on enabling a new SSO configuration or utilizing an existing configuration. Users will also receive descriptive error messages when trying to sync or upload an XML file, and the system cannot properly connect with the certificate repository.</p>
Transportation	<p>Transportation 2.0 is available. District Support is asking that no one enable to the new transportation tool currently. Once KDE testing is completed, districts will be notified that the new tool can be enabled if desired. For questions about the transportation tools, contact Ronda Devine by email.</p>

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
