# Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.2411 Kentucky Specific

<b>Career Readiness</b>	The following dictionary updates have been made:
	• The data dictionary for Status was updated to include IP = In-Progress and F = Failed and is the field is now required.
	• The data dictionary for Type has been updated to make codes 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, and 12 inactive. The active options now include, 3- Cooperative education, 9= Paid Internship, and 11- Unpaid Internship.

	Hours is now required.
Dropout Report	A student who withdrawals as a W26 should not be counted as a dropout if that student was age 17 or older at the time of withdrawal date, enrolled in an alternative education program (A5 or A6 School Classification), has a completed Diploma Type of 4 or 6, and has a Diploma Date on or before October 1 of the withdrawal year.  In addition, 4 new fields have been added to the report: Age, State Classification, Diploma Type, and Diploma Date.
ILPA Template Banks	One of the <u>ILPA Template Bank</u> types, Criteria for Re-enrollment, has been renamed to Transition Criteria.
ILPA Plans	Two new checkboxes, Behavior Records and Attendance Records, have been added to the Student Records editor on the <u>Kentucky Individual Learning Plan Addendum (ILPA)</u> document.
Retention Report	An issue when generating the <u>Retention Report</u> in State Edition when the Campus toolbar had been set to All Districts/All Schools has been resolved.
Safe Schools	The logic and error message for ER06 in <u>Safe Schools</u> report will only produce if a behavior event has a response of Restraint or Seclusion and no corresponding resolution mapped to state resolution code of SSP7 or SSP8.
Special Education	The Kentucky Special Education Document font size has been increased to improve readability on all printed documents.

Accessibility	Menu items and color indicators within Campus which only convey their status by showing as highlighted have been updated to now announce "current" to screen reader software.  The following updated we made to improve accessibility:  • Pill button group in User Advanced Search properly announcing "group" for screen reader.

	Accessibility enhancements were made to the Parent and Student Portal for My Cart and School Store.
Ad hoc reporting	There was an issue with results not displaying in the New Look of Campus when using the search functionality in the Ad Hoc <u>Filter Designer</u> and Advanced Search with filters when All Years/All Calendars was selected. This has been corrected and filters search results display as expected.
Assessments	Fuzzy Matching logic has been updated to enhance the <u>Assessment Center</u> user experience. The character limit for Test Score fields has been increased from 20 characters to 50 characters.  The deprecation of the original assessment tools has been delayed to a future release.
Campus Instruction	Performance improvements have been made in addition to the correction of a load issue that some teachers were experiencing with <a href="Teaching Center">Teaching Center</a> .
Counseling	An issue where the <u>Team Members tool</u> was not displaying a staff members' current name has been fixed.  The Log Contact check log on the <u>Counseling Meetings</u> tool now defaults to unmarked when adding more than on student at a time.
FRAM	Added the ability for <u>FRAM</u> Administrators to attach a default signature to canned/default letters.
Health	When a medication dose is administered to a student during a Health Office Visit, a Medication record is also created on the student's Medications tool. With this update, the date of the medication record is now the date the medication was administered to the student, not the date the Health Office Visit record was created. This allows users to create

	address information when a person has been end-dated from a household and added to a
	new household. This has been corrected.
	Added the ability to enter email addresses and phone numbers to non-campus/external
	recipients to Messenger 2.0 messages.
OneRoster	An option has been added to the <u>Connection Configuration</u> section of <u>OneRoster 1.2</u>
	connections allowing users to control whether the connection should include address data
	in the demographics data made available via the OneRoster API.
	Logic has been updated so that a <u>cache refresh</u> is triggered when the Combine Person tool
	is used to ensure accurate data. Logic has also been updated so that the paging algorithms

Security	In the New Look of Infinite Campus, users were incorrectly able to select Combine Person
	tool rights for a User Group. This issue was corrected as Combine Person tool rights are to
	only be assigned on a per-person basis due to its ability to cause costly damage if used
	without caution.
Transportation	A test connection button has been added to the UI allowing users to verify information will
	sync with <u>Traversa</u> .
