Please be advised that KDE has confirmed the release of **Campus.2435** to start **Wednesday, September 18, at 7:00 p.m., (Central)/ 8:00 p.m. (Eastern)**. Please note, we originally planned to implement **Campus.2435** on September 11. However, we postponed the release to ensure the [Dual Credit Scholarship Report](#) can be submitted to KHEAA by the **September 15** deadline, before the Roster Batch Edit tool is replaced by the Section Student Detail tool. Campus will convert the data from Roster Batch Edit to Section Student Detail but is not part of this release.

### Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.2435

#### Kentucky Specific

Item	Description
<b>Career Readiness</b>	Multiple updates have been made to Error requirements, and the extract editor's default format has been changed to HTML for the Validation Report.
<b>Kentucky Special Ed Amend Dates Update</b>	Kentucky users can now have an Amendment Start and End Dates on the same day as the plan's original Start and End Dates to comply with KDE standards. This applies to the Individual Education Plan and Private School Plans for Kentucky.
<b>Safe Schools Report</b>	An issue with duplicates when running the Safe Schools report has been resolved. Also, issues with missing data related to SSP3 (out-of-school suspension) when there are Restraint/Seclusion responses present and Events V19 (Hazing 1st degree) and V20 (Hazing 2nd degree) have been resolved.
<b>Section Information</b>	The <a href="#">Section Student Detail</a> tool has been added and includes Dual Credit, No Credit, and Repeat fields. This replaces the Roster Batch Edit tool for these data elements. Tool rights will need to be assigned to the appropriate user groups.

#### Core Product

Item	Description
<b>Academic Planning</b>	Courses using the Parent/Child Planning rule were not reflected on the student's <a href="#">Academic Planning Progress</a> list of courses. This has been corrected.
<b>Campus Student &amp; Parent</b>	Previously, if a district modified their district-defined help in the Campus Parent or Campus Student app to include their phone number, Google searches prioritized that phone number over the number of Infinite Campus in search results, causing an increase in calls to the district. This has been corrected.
<b>English Learner</b>	An issue was identified in which some students with multiple active EL records had a historical record without an end date. A query has been implemented to isolate these records and change their status to Exited LEP.
<b>Health</b>	The list of CDC vaccine codes was updated for the 24-25 school year. See the <a href="#">Vaccine Mappings</a> article for additional information
<b>Infrastructure</b>	An issue was causing users to receive an error token when attempting to upload a file via an import tool (such as the Eligibility Import Wizard, User Account Batch Import Tool, etc). This issue was corrected.
<b>One Roster</b>	Previously, when a course had two instances of the same Grading Task aligned, one of which was marked as Post Only, the Uncategorized Assignments tool treated both instances a Post Only and did not list the other Grading Task. This has been corrected.
<b>Records Transfer</b>	An Evaluation Error was being generated when records transfers were being released. This has been corrected.
<b>Security</b>	Users could not log into Infinite Campus if their system had two or more active SSO configurations. This issue was corrected. Within Classic Campus, users with proper Read tool rights to Student Information were prevented from searching for students. This issue was corrected.

#### Core Product Enhancements

Item	Description
<b>Census Rules Data Validations Group</b>	Added the ability to run the Census Rules Data Validations Group on a selected school or year.
<b>Course Planner - Additional Course Filter Options</b>	<p>The Course Planner Filter for Batch Edit Course Information has been updated to include additional parameters. Users can enter a value for Terms, Schedules, Periods, etc., to return courses meeting those values. They can also select a "Where" value and choose an operator (=, &gt;, etc.) like what is available in Filter Designer.</p> <p>Sections to Build can now be set to a specific value (Text Fill Value) OR to the value from last year's sections, sections needed, or sections placed.</p>
<b>Custom Forms State Edition Publish to Districts Functionality Added</b>	State Edition users can now create an Interactive or Blank Custom Form and publish it for all districts. When districts attach the form to a student, enter data, and lock it, the form automatically syncs back to the state. This applies to all newly created Custom Forms but not existing forms. See the Custom Form Setup article for additional information.
<b>Schedule Wizard and Related Scheduling Tools Removed</b>	<p>Over the last few years, the tools available for building courses, loading requests, planning for staff and necessary courses, and managing rosters have been redesigned with new technology. Those tools are: Scheduling Board, Course Planner, Staff Planner, and Requests &amp; Rosters</p> <p>The following tools have been removed from Campus: Schedule Wizard, Scheduling Build Constraints Wizard, Course Build Constraints, Section Roster Batch Edit, Request Wizard, Roster Copy, and Section Roster Setup.</p>
<b>Signing In to Google Drive</b>	The process for authenticating a Google account has been updated to accommodate recent changes by Google. Integrating Google Drive files functions the same way, but the sign-in process has been simplified. Teachers and students are still prompted to log in to Google Drive when interacting with a file. Additionally, a "Change" button has been added to the teacher's Preferences and the student's Google sign-in screen to allow users to manage which account they're signed into.
<b>Special Ed Documents Amendment Start Date Update</b>	The Amendment Start Date is now displayed in the Document Detail of amended plans. This information can be queried in Ad hoc (Query Wizard > Student > Learner Planning > Learning Plans > learningPlan.amendStartDate). See the Amend Special Ed Documents article for additional information.
<b>Cross-Site Enrollment - Course, Roster and Enrollment Data Syncing</b>	All Cross-Site Enrollment data related to Courses, Course Sections, Rosters, and Enrollments now syncs with other district data. This daily syncing process ensures that interdistrict Cross-Site Enrollment data is up-to-date.
<b>Cross-Site Enrollment - Home School View, Print Serving School Day Rotation and Period Schedule</b>	Home School users can now print the Calendar Report and the Period Schedules Report for the Serving School. These reports can be printed from the Cross-Site Enrollment setup tool.
<b>Cross-Site Enrollment - Non-Instructional Events Displayed for Home School</b>	<p>For students enrolled in Cross-Site Courses, an indication that the Serving School does not meet on a certain day now displays on the student's Schedule when viewing from the Home School.</p> <p>This can be viewed when looking at the student's schedule in the Day, Week, and Agenda views, available when using the Calendar option to view the student's schedule. That course for the day is highlighted, and when selected to view details in the side panel, additional text displays indicating the course doesn't meet for that day/period.</p>
<b>Cross-Site Enrollment - School Connections</b>	A new tool called School Connections has been added to the Cross-Site Enrollment toolset for use with Intradistrict Cross-Site Enrollment Participation. This tool determines which schools can share/map courses with other schools. Only those schools marked as eligible for service are displayed in the Cross-Site Enrollment Setup tool.

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
