Report changes in this release include:

Report Name Change - The [Early Literacy Diagnostic](#) report was renamed dropping the word ‘Screener’ from the name. The name change will require assigning tool rights for those needing access to the report. This release includes State Single Sign On (SSO) functionality. The configuration is hidden from the district and portal login screens to avoid confusion or extra clicks for district SSO users.

**Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.2547**  
**Kentucky Specific**

Item	Description
<b>Archived Plan and Evaluation Documents</b>	Several Plan and Evaluation print formats were archived for Kentucky. This means that new documents cannot be created for an archived print format; however, existing documents created for a student in that format are unaffected. Archived formats include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• KY Eval 2016-Revised</li><li>• KY Conference Summary 2016 - Revised (historical)</li><li>• KY ILPA 2019</li><li>• KY ILPA 2016</li></ul> KY ILPA
<b>DIS</b>	The CustomDistrict DIS object was enabled for Kentucky. KDE will schedule a batch sync for the Moral Instruction Provider data for all districts.

Item	Description
<b>ILPA</b>	The School List on the <a href="#">Individual Learning Plan Addendum</a> (ILPA) was updated for Kentucky. This update includes adding new schools, deactivating schools no longer in use, and updating school names.
<b>State to District Login</b>	<p>A new State to District Login tool is now available in the Kentucky State Edition of Campus. This tool allows users (assigned to specific user groups) to seamlessly log into a district's Campus site (as themselves) using a preconfigured SSO connection.</p> <p>At the district level, districts will see a State Single Sign-On (SSO) configuration enabled in their SAML – SSO Service Provider Configuration tool. This configuration allows the state to log into your district site. You can disable it, however doing so removes the ability for the state to log into your site.</p> <p>Campus Technical Services supports a standard set of read only tool rights for the KDEAdmin, KDEAudit, and KDEHealth user groups in all districts. Each district may change what tools are assigned however doing so may impede KDE staff from providing support. Access to Wizards is intentionally not granted as Read tool rights allows a user to change data. These groups should not be given Write, Add or Delete tool rights.</p>
<b>GSSP (currently in production)</b>	An issue was fixed where Gifted and Talented Service Plan documents created after the Campus Release 2535, but before the RX fix 2539, could not be opened or printed.
<b>Preschool Enrollment Count (currently in production)</b>	<p>Several issues were addressed in the Kentucky Preschool Enrollment Count report.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students were not being counted appropriately in the Y4atRisk, Y4WDisabilityatRisk, and Y4WDisabilityOverIncome columns. Missing columns were added for Y4HeadStartEnhanced and Y2orY3orY4WODisabilityOverIncome.</li> <li>The column order on the Kentucky <a href="#">Preschool Enrollment Count</a> report was updated to improve report clarity.</li> <li>An issue was fixed where the Preschool Enrollment Count report was not reporting students in grade 99.</li> </ul> <p>Elements Y4WDisabilityatRisk and Y4WDisabilityOverIncome on the Kentucky Preschool Count extract now correctly require those students to have a Preschool Type of State Funded with Disabilities.</p>

#### Core Product

Item	Description
<b>Ad hoc Reporting</b>	Previously, teachers without Unfiltered Search access could view results for all students within the selected calendar when using the <a href="#">Filter Designer</a> tool and the <a href="#">Data Viewer</a> tool. The search logic has been refined to deliver more targeted and relevant data. Results are now limited to students assigned to a teacher's course sections within the selected calendar.
<b>Attendance</b>	<p>An issue where the <a href="#">Classroom Monitor Tool</a> was not updating to green for sections spanning multiple periods after a recent update has been corrected.</p> <p>The attendance <a href="#">seating chart</a> now displays correctly in full screen when taking attendance. This resolves an issue where the seating chart did not fill the entire screen after recent updates to the Attendance list released in Campus.2543.</p>
<b>Campus Learning</b>	<p>New! Groups - A Staff, Parent, and Student Communication Tool A new Groups tool has been added to Campus Learning. This tool allows users to create groups that include students, parents, and staff members and communicate with them via Campus. These groups can be created around events, topics, organizations, and interests. Depending on group settings, members can create posts and reply to others in the group.</p> <p>New! Add Math Equations to Rich Text Fields This enhancement allows users to insert mathematical equations into rich text fields in curriculum. Click the equation button to build a math equation using common mathematical</p>

	<p>operators, characters, and formulas. This feature makes it easier for teachers in math and science courses to include complex equations in quizzes and other assignments, beyond what can be typed using a standard keyboard.</p> <p>Curriculum Copier Access Improved for Teachers Teachers can now use the <a href="#">Curriculum Copier</a> without requiring calendar rights to previous school years.</p>
<b>OneRoster</b>	<p>Updates have been made to improve the performance of the Students endpoint in OneRoster 1.2, including the getAllStudents and getStudentsForSchool endpoints. (CUES)</p> <p>This release includes improvements to our LTI 1.3 Assignments &amp; Grades integration. Contact your LTI vendor to see if they support the LTI 1.3 version of the specification.</p>
<b>Cross-Site Enrollment</b>	KDE will be testing the additional <a href="#">course data elements</a> from the Serving School to the Home School are now transferred for Cross-Site Enrollment courses. This allows for more accurate posting of transcript data and state reporting information.
<b>Custom</b>	<p>The <a href="#">Custom Tools Publisher</a> now includes filtering and sorting options for the Custom Tools list and Publishing Status columns on the main page and the Publishing Queued Date and Status columns in the history view.</p> <p><a href="#">Task Scheduler</a> was also updated to ensure any selected filtering or sorting options remain selected when navigating to different screens within the tool.</p> <p>The Update Parent button is no longer available for custom tools with a tool type of URL Editor or URL Link or for tools with a Search Option set to School or District.</p>
<b>Data Utilities</b>	Now, when editing extract details within the <a href="#">Data Extract Utilities</a> tool, sorting and/or filtering selected on the main tool page is preserved when returning from the edit screen.
<b>Early Warning</b>	A performance issue causing slow loading times for the Curriculum data window in the Early Warning tool has been resolved. The Curriculum flyout window now loads properly for all students and schools.
<b>FRAM</b>	Resolved an issue where <a href="#">importing</a> a new school year's file using a previously saved mapping did not correctly apply the new school year.
<b>Messenger</b>	<p>The <a href="#">Sent Message Log 2.0</a> display has been updated to improve readability when a message campaign includes a large number of calendars. Calendars are now listed one per row instead of in a comma-separated list. For messages with more than 10 calendars, the list is initially condensed with a "See More" option to expand the full list.</p> <p>Enhanced our ability to reload the email dispatch thread to allow tuning of the email thread count and batch size. Additionally, this enables the system to recover more effectively from errors or misconfigurations.</p> <p>Error confirmation emails for <a href="#">Messenger 2.0</a> have been standardized to provide consistent information across all message types.</p>
<b>Records Transfer</b>	An issue where high school transcript entries were not appearing in Records Transfer has been corrected. Logic has been updated to select the most recent enrollment based on start date, rather than relying solely on the maximum enrollment ID. This change ensures more accurate and complete student records are included in transfers, particularly for students with multiple enrollments across different school years.
<b>Scheduling</b>	<p>Making changes to an offering through the Staff History or Roster tools caused an infinite loop of searching. This has been corrected, AND additional updates to the <a href="#">Responsive Scheduling Section Builder</a> tool have been made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Teacher column is now Primary Teacher.</li> <li>• The list of sessions is now searchable.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional teachers can now be added to a section when adding an offering or managing an offering.</li> <li>• The Roster of an offering can now be printed in PDF format once the offering is scheduled.</li> </ul> <p>The Edit link next to section offerings on <a href="#">Course Sections</a> now redirects users to the Responsive Schedule Section Builder tool for responsive courses.</p>
<b>Security</b>	<p>We resolved an issue where multi-factor authentication (MFA) was incorrectly prompted during Single Sign-On (SSO) login. MFA is now properly disabled for authentication types other than local campus authentication.</p> <p>State-owned SAML configurations have been removed as a selectable option in various user account management tools. This change affects the <a href="#">User Account Type Wizard</a>, <a href="#">Account Security Preferences</a>, <a href="#">User Account Batch Wizard</a>, and <a href="#">User Account Batch Import Tool</a>. Additionally, these configurations will no longer send certificate expiration warning emails.</p>

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
