

School Report Card – Portal Open for District Data Review

The [School Report Card \(SRC\) Portal](#) is now open for: 1) District and school verification and approval of School Safety data; and 2) Collection of the School Profile Report and other SRC data needed from schools and districts. Other SRC domains will open for review and approval in August and September. The full timeline is available on the [School Report Card Resources webpage](#) and the tentative public release date is Oct. 15.

- The School Safety review period ends Aug. 12 to meet [KRS 158.444](#) reporting deadlines for the Kentucky Center for School Safety and the Office of Education Accountability. The following resources and steps can assist with the review:
 - Use the [Validation of Safety Data for School Report Card Instructions](#) to support this work using the Safe Schools report in Infinite Campus.
 - Reviewers may flag School Safety data issues in the portal if issues are found. A flag indicates a potential data concern, please include as much detail as possible so the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) has the information needed to research the issue.
 - To indicate completion, approve the domain at the district level. KDE does not review school-level approvals; however, districts may require schools to verify school-level data and indicate approval before district approval.
 - District Safe Schools Administrators were notified of the [School Safety Review Period](#) and associated tasks on July 15.
- The SRC Collection period ends Sept. 25 prior to public opening of the SRC.
 - The SRC Portal Collection Tool is used by schools and districts to report [SRC Collection Items](#). KDE does not collect these data elsewhere and the data is required for the School Profile Report

- School-level reporting includes Access to Technology, Career Studies, Health Education and Physical Education, Ineffective Teachers, Parent Involvement, Precautionary Measures, School Information, Visual and Performing Arts, and World Languages.
- District-level reporting includes only the superintendent's message which is optional.
