

School Report Card – SRC Portal Closes Sept. 30

Thanks to all those working on the 2025-2026 School Report Card (SRC) data entry and data verification. A lot of work has already been done, and we thank those in the district that have already completed this work. This is a friendly reminder of the items that need to be completed by the end of this month. The [School Report Card Secure Portal](#) is open and districts can complete each of these tasks within that tool.

- Quality Control (QC) day for assessment and accountability data is scheduled for Sept. 23; District Assessment Coordinators (DACs) are provided details on that review process through separate communications.
- Districts that want to include a superintendent message should enter that in the Collection Tool by Sept. 25.
- Schools should complete entry of their [collection data](#) in the Collection Tool by Sept. 25.
- School and district staff should complete their review of the Overview and Education Opportunity domains in the Preview Tool by Sept. 25. Flag and provide details if any issues are found within the Preview Tool.
- Monitor school/district flags in the Approval Tool, reach out to [KDE Data Services](#) for referral to the appropriate KDE contact if there is need to discuss.
- Once data is reviewed and any issues are resolved, please use the Approval Tool to approve these two domains no later than Sept. 25. KDE monitors district-level approvals as an indicator that all schools have verified and the district has completed SRC tasks associated with each domain.
- Career and Technical Education (CTE) and Transition to Adult Life domains will open Sept. 15. Please review and approve that data by Sept. 30.
- The School Profile Report must be printed and signed by principals, school-based decision-making members and superintendents, as applicable. The signed School Profile Report should be available in the local board office by Oct. 1.
- SRC Embargo opens Oct. 13 and public release is scheduled for Oct. 15.
