Specifically, PCHS needs to add additional personnel and technology in order to improve student achievement with our most needy population. While progress monitoring is currently in place for learning labs, the current system is in need of refinement. A more strategic approach is needed to isolate specific deficit skills areas for individual students, and then to provide direct instruction in those areas. Technology will be needed for students to practice skills while working with the academic intervention specialist, so a small number of laptops are also being requested. An effective progress monitoring tool, staff to review the data, and specialists to deliver the instruction to meet individual needs will be required in order to improve the Tier III supports. Additional intervention strategies to better meet the needs of students in this category is also needed [...]”

MUNIS Budget Request Change: 734

Technology is needed to support the work of the Academic Intervention Specialist (AIS) in her classroom. The AIS position is funded through the SIG Grant. She provides tier 3 academic supports for students not making adequate progress through our tier 2 interventions, and often blends online learning with other activities to meet the needs of students. We are requesting to purchase four student laptops with funds remaining from MUNIS Code 734, which would be a great addition to her current technology. She has 6 desktop computers in her room, but they are among the oldest in the building. Furthermore, she is often displaced to other locations, and the laptops would enable her to more easily continue with regular activities. We were originally approved for \$17,000 for 60 Chromebooks and two carts, but the actual total for these items was \$13,768. Therefore, we are requesting to use most of the remaining \$3,232 to purchase four student laptops, at approximately \$724.44 per laptop. The information on the laptops is below:
