The new JCPS Accelerated Improvement Office will now be providing training for teachers during the summer reducing the need for SIG to be used on this work. To support the needs of the school in-line with the school improvement priorities, a more appropriate use of funds is to provide appropriate Tier I instructional focus. In order to make the best use of the funds available to Olmsted Academy North and to meet the needs we see for building teacher capacity in data analysis, comprehensive planning, and implementing high quality instruction, we would like to redirect funds so that Olmsted Academy North is able to purchase supplemental books to support implementation of a new English/Language Arts curriculum as well as provide additional time for teachers to collaborate toward the implementation of rigorous tier I instruction. The district and school-based instructional coaches will provide professional development for English/Language Arts, math, science, and social studies. Additionally, these funds will be utilized to ensure quality materials to provide support and grade-level access for teachers to best serve the student population at Olmsted Academy North.</p> <p>Olmsted Academy North would like to redirect funds in the following fashion:</p>
