These Chromebooks will assist students in online learning through Google Classroom, conducting research and independent study as some new courses will be offered in the 2019-2020 school year online allowing students a more individually tailored approach. This will increase student achievement by allowing teachers to more frequently and efficiently formatively assess students through the use of Google Classroom.
