At this time, those Chromebooks are now obsolete and are also a technology hazard for use as they no longer can receive critical updates.</p> <p>With this amendment, we would like to purchase 128 Chromebooks to begin a phase out system of the 440 that were originally purchased, with plans to use other funds to sustain a reoccurring phase of purchasing Chromebooks in the coming school years.</p> <p>128 Chromebooks allows us to replace an existing cart of Chromebooks for each core department, 32 to each cart. What we have seen with our increase in Chromebooks is also an increase in student and teachers to utilize the various Google Suite products, increase use of student response system programs, web-based research, and project based and student centered learning. At the same time we have seen increased communication and involvement among teachers and students through this technology.</p>

		<p>By replacing and phasing future purchases of Chromebooks we are creating a system that ensures Chromebooks that can be maintained and updated to meet student, teacher, and technology needs.</p> <p>Each Chromebook costs \$297. So we would be using \$38,000-\$40,000 to make this purchase.</p> <p>Funds would be moved from Munis Codes 0338 and 0580 which are related to travel and registration. The COVID-19 situation cancelled multiple conferences that we were planning to use the funds for that we now cannot use those funds for that purpose. We will be transferring \$20,000 from each budgeted amount and move them to 0734.</p>
