FLOAN is in year 2 of the Rutherford Coaching with JCPS as part of the SIF FY19 and FY20. These materials will support this ongoing professional learning in the area of teacher development. The materials to be purchased include:</p> <p>*Rutherford Coaching books & Memory jogger – \$17.50 (Artisan Teacher) x 25 books - <u>\$437.50</u> \$14.50 (7 tools for Developing Teachers and Teaching) X 25 books = <u>\$362.50</u> \$3.50 x 100 memory jogger cards - <u>\$350</u> <u>Rutherford Materials Total - \$1,150.</u></p> <p>Another area of professional learning FLOAN has initiated is KAGAN strategies. In our current SIF FY20, teachers will be trained in stages in this cooperative learning strategy. To support the professional learning, FLOAN would like to purchase the Cooperative Learning book - \$44/ea</p>

		<p>X 60 = <u>\$2,640</u>. This covers the cost of a book for each classroom teacher.</p> <p>Finally, FLOAN has an immediate need to help teachers provide more coherent instruction during the pandemic which has led to distance learning. Teachers will receive Embedded Professional Development using the Distance Learning Playbook (\$24/ea X 60 = <u>\$1,440</u>).</p> <p>We will continue to supplement classrooms with high interest reading materials by purchasing Scholastic for another year - *Scholastic order – <u>\$3,659.00</u></p>
<p>Section 4: Timeline</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Three year timeline 		<p>The funds in 0322 were originally marked to pay for other educational consultant (STEAM); however, due to COVID 19, the opportunity for outside Professional learning is slim to non-existent. So, in consultation with the ILT/school turnaround team, this also helps address IP 2 which addresses Professional Learning Communities.</p> <p>In order to cover the cost of materials to be purchased, please move \$7,078.59 from 6202551 0322 460C, and \$110.79 from 6202170 0643 460C to 6202219 0643 460C. This, plus the balance of 1,699.62 will bring the amount to \$8,889.00, as approved in the SIG spending plan.</p>
