## Summary of Policy and Compact General Requirements

- Developed jointly with, agreed on with and distributed to parents of participating children.
- Written in a format and language that parents can understand.
  - Avoid excessive technical language/jargon which may be unfamiliar to individuals outside the education field.
  - Consider how the documents can be made available in a language other than English as needed.
- Evaluated for effective implementation.
- Regularly reviewed and revised as needed.



## Policy v. Compact

- District Parent and Family Engagement Policy [ESSA 1116(a)(2)]
  - Establishes expectations and objectives for meaningful parent and family engagement as well as describes how the district will meet those expectations and objectives.
- School Parent and Family Engagement Policy [ESSA 1116(b)]
  - Describes the means for carrying out the requirements outlined in ESSA 1116(c)-(f).
- School Compact [ESSA 1116(d)]
  - Outlines how parents, the entire school staff and students will share the
    responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means
    by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership to
    help children achieve the state's high standards.



## Common Policy and Compact Compliance Issues

- Required information is missing.
- Policy lists the program requirements but does not include details on how the district/school will meet them.
- There is no evidence that the documents were developed jointly with parents.
- No evidence the activities described in the policy are taking place.
- Compact does not have space for stakeholder signatures as required by KDE.
- Documents are not being reviewed regularly and revised as needed.

- Districts and schools are not required to use the templates provided by KDE.




# Reviewing and Revising Policies and Compacts

- Parent and family engagement policies and compact should be reviewed on a regular basis and revised as needed.
- ESSA does not specify the frequency of review or the time of year in which it should occur.
  - Consider what works best for your parent population.
    - Ask for feedback and suggested revisions when reviewing the documents with parents during the annual meeting.
    - Wait to obtain feedback until the spring so that parents can reflect on how effective the documents were throughout the school year.
    - Consider an additional opportunity to provide feedback during parent-teacher conferences.
