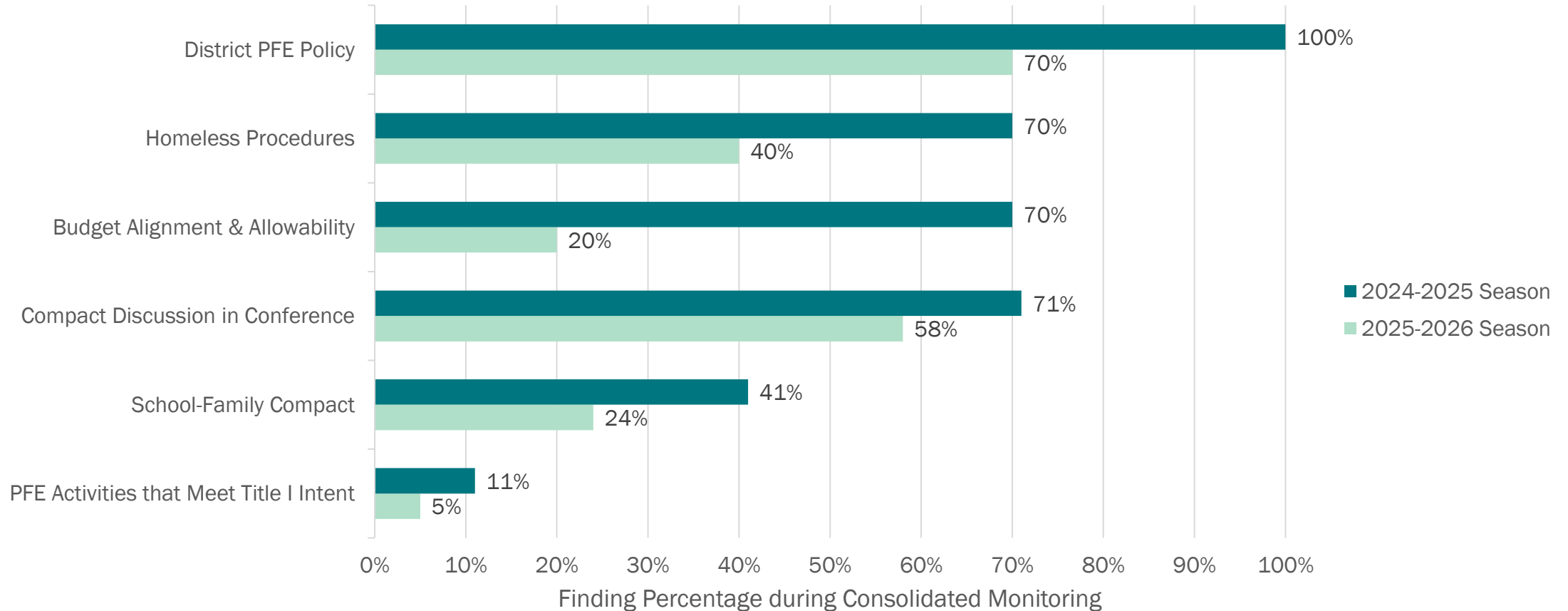
Year at a Glance: Suggested Tasks for Summer

- Meet with district financial staff to reconcile fiscal issues prior to the end-of-year closeout. This will help ensure the district will not exceed the 15% carryover limitation.
- Review time and effort documentation for staff paid partially with Title I funds to determine the actual percentage of time spent working on the Title I, Part A program. If the percentage of time does not align with the full-time equivalency (FTE) listed in the GMAP application, the application should be updated. Similar adjustments must be made in Enterprise ERP (EERP) to ensure Title I funds pay for the accurate percentage of the employee's salary.
- Discuss requirements for completing the annual comparability calculations in the fall. For example, who will obtain and verify student enrollment and FTE of instructional staff at all schools?
- Gather data on Title I services provided at participating private schools during the 2025-2026 school year and evaluate the implementation and effectiveness of those services. Discuss and analyze the data with private school officials during the consultation meeting to determine if the same or similar services will be appropriate in meeting student needs for the upcoming school year.
- Work with Title I schools to review program implementation and effectiveness and plan for the upcoming year.
- Review and update district and school parent and family engagement (PFE) policies and school-family compact based on data (e.g., evaluations), jointly with parents, as needed.

2025-2026 Monitoring Season Overview

- 22 districts participated in some form of Title I, Part A program monitoring during the 2025-2026 school year.
 - Title I, Part A desk monitoring: 12 districts
 - Statewide consolidated monitoring: 10 districts, 41 schools and 6 participating non-public schools
- Each monitored site received an actions needed form outlining the following:
 - Strengths
 - Findings
 - Recommendations

 - Must happen at least once a year at the elementary level.

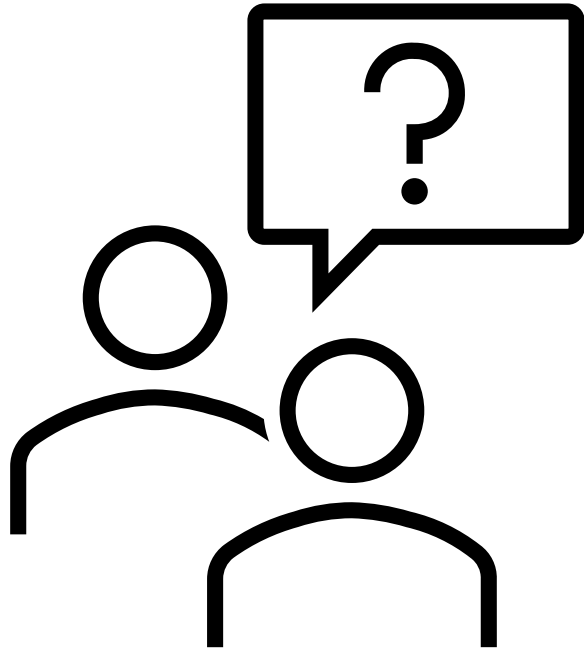
