State Assessment Proficiency Status Section

Purpose

To provide instruction on the *State Assessment Proficiency Status* section of the Title I-D Performance Report.

Reporting Year

FY2026 Title I-D Performance Report should collect data from the 2025-2026 school year.

Requirement

Facilities should report the number of students served by Title I, Part D, who participated in a statewide assessment for mathematics and reading. In Kentucky, the state assessment is the Kentucky Summative Assessment (KSA).

Obtaining the Data

The reporting year is 2025-2026; therefore, facilities must use the 2025-2026 KSA results to determine these counts. The KSA vendor data files have been delivered to the district. Facilities should work with the District Assessment Coordinator to obtain the data for the students counted in the *Demographics Data* section of the Title I-D Performance Report as the unduplicated count of students who were served between July 1 and June 30 of the fiscal year being reported.

Data Entry

Not Proficient – Math – enter the number of students who received Novice or Apprentice on the math portion of the KSA.

Attained Proficiency – Reading – enter the number of students who received Proficient or Distinguished on the reading portion of the KSA.

Not Proficient – Reading – enter the number of students who received Novice or Apprentice on the reading portion of the KSA.
