Design, Align, Deliver Support Processes

OPERATIONAL DEFINITION

School/District leaders must establish a framework that organizes systems, data, and practices to promote positive, equitable and inclusive learning experiences for all students. Ongoing continuous improvement and data-based decision making should occur at all levels to match instruction, intervention, and support to the identified needs of all learners. Resources are aligned to needs in order to make all systems work together for continuous improvement and success.

POSSIBLE ACTIVITIES

- Establish/Revisit/Refine a process that aligns resources (e.g., human, fiscal, logistical) to the identified needs of students.
- Develop/Refine/Revise a multi-tiered system of supports, driven by data (e.g., universal screener, diagnostic and progress-monitoring, student surveys) that addresses the social-emotional, academic and behavioral needs of all students.
- Establish a system that will ensure students are offered exploration of both academic and career opportunities (e.g., advanced coursework, dual credit, gifted and talented, CTE pathways) through student choice, community partnerships and resources appropriate to the local area.
- Establish/Revisit/Refine a system to monitor the overall effectiveness of a multi-tiered system of supports.
- Implement the use of quality tools (e.g., PDSA, Root Cause Analysis, Fishbone) as part of a continuous improvement cycle to support high-quality intervention and enrichment.
