

“Through National Board Certification, teachers demonstrate that their teaching meets the profession’s standards for accomplished practice through a rigorous, peer-reviewed and performance-based process, similar to professional certification in fields such as medicine. In achieving Board certification, teachers prove their ability to advance student learning and achievement” (The Proven Impact of Board-Certified Teachers on Student Achievement, [NBPTS Impact Brief](#)).

More than a decade of research from across the country confirms that students taught by National Board Certified Teachers (NBCTs) learn more than students taught by other teachers. Estimates of the increase in learning are on the order of an additional one to two months of instruction and the positive impact is even greater for high-need students (Board Certification: A Proven Tool for Identifying Quality of Teaching, [NBPTS Research and Policy Implications](#)).

In Kentucky, 4,022 teachers have achieved National Board certification. Kentucky ranks 6th in the nation for the percentage of teachers who are Board-certified (9.53%), 8th in the nation for the total number of Board-certified teachers and 5th in the nation for the number of newly certified teachers in 2019 ([NBPTS In Your State: Kentucky](#)).

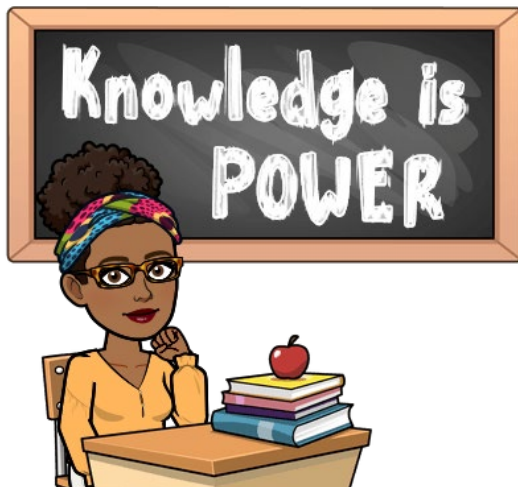
